### ADMISSION/SEATING

All seats are free on a first-come, first-served basis. No ticket required.

### DEAF/HARD OF HEARING

Sign Language interpretation will be available in Section 20. Reserved seats will be held until 30 minutes prior to the start of the program. Hearing Assistance devices are available at the Civic Center.

### HANDOUT POLICY

Pursuant to the City of Dothan Ordinances Sec. 62-4, guests are not allowed to hand out promotional or advertisement brochures, fliers or any other printed material to other guests while on the parking lots or in the Dothan Civic Center.

### LOST AND FOUND

If an item is lost or found during the Celebration services, please go to the Command Center near the Concession Stand on the ground floor. After the services, you may call the Celebration office at 334-446-5778 between 8:30AM and 5:00PM weekdays.

### CONCESSION STANDS

Concession stands will be available during the Celebration music program. All concessions will be closed during Will Graham's message. All non-concession food and drinks are prohibited.

### PROHIBITED ITEMS

We ask all guests to arrive early and travel light as you may be subject to search upon entry. For safety reasons, prohibited items include but are not limited to: alcohol, drugs, illegal substances or any drug paraphernalia, audio/video recorders, professional cameras, tripods, cans, bottles, coolers or other similar containers, fireworks, flags/signs with poles, laser pens/pointers of any type, noisemakers such as air horns, outside food or drinks, oversized bags, backpacks, duffel bags, pepper spray/mace, weapons of any type, including chains, knives, firearms and spiked jewelry, any other item deemed unacceptable by event/building management. If an item is revealed during a search, patrons may dispose of the item or they may return the item to their vehicle. The Dothan Civic Center does not safeguard any personal belongings or other items.

- Turn left onto Main Street

- Turn left onto N St. Andrews Street

## Directions from Geneva, AL:

- Take AL 52 into Dothan
- Turn right onto Main Street
- Turn left onto N St. Andrews Street

- Take US 231 into Dothan
- Continue on Oates Street
- Turn right onto Main Street
- Turn left onto N St. Andrews Street

## Directions from Cottonwood, AL:

- Take AL 53 into Dothan
